#### **Blood Collection and Handling - Dried Blood Spot (DBS)**

Completing filling the circle is important because the laboratory will need to use a hole puncher to punch a section of the circle of blood for testing If collecting spots using a pipette, collect 100 µl of blood and gently apply to filter paper

#### **HOW TO COLLECT BLOOD SPOTS - PerkinElmer**

Allow a drop of blood to form that will be large enough to fill the circle printed on the collection card Collect the blood on the rear side of the card only Make sure that blood fills the circle completely and saturates the paper right through Apply only once to each circle Do not layer Fill all of the circles with blood
