Females aged 10-19 years sustained sports- and recreation-related TBIs most often while playing soccer or basketball or while bicycling<sup>16</sup> More than 248,000 children visited hospital emergency departments in 2009 for concussions and other traumatic brain injuries related to sports and recreation<sup>17</sup>
